## Skills and competences for an Ambient Assisted Living Specialist/Consultant



Europe is becoming an Aging Society.

The consequences of the demographic change represent an exceptional challenge for the European Union and its public health and elderly care systems.

Yet, these systems are highly demanding to those planning, installing and maintaining them as to the caregivers as well.

Are the Europeans ready to cope with this reality? While ICT based assistance systems enable the elderly to stay longer in their familiar surroundings, skilled AAL professionals are lacking.

Against this background, the engAGEnt project will develop a harmonised European curriculum for vocational training that qualifies people for the job role of an AAL specialist/consultant. This job profile will include the knowledge, skills and competences for analysing the living situation of an elderly or physically impaired person and developing strategies to improve the living conditions of the elderly population.
